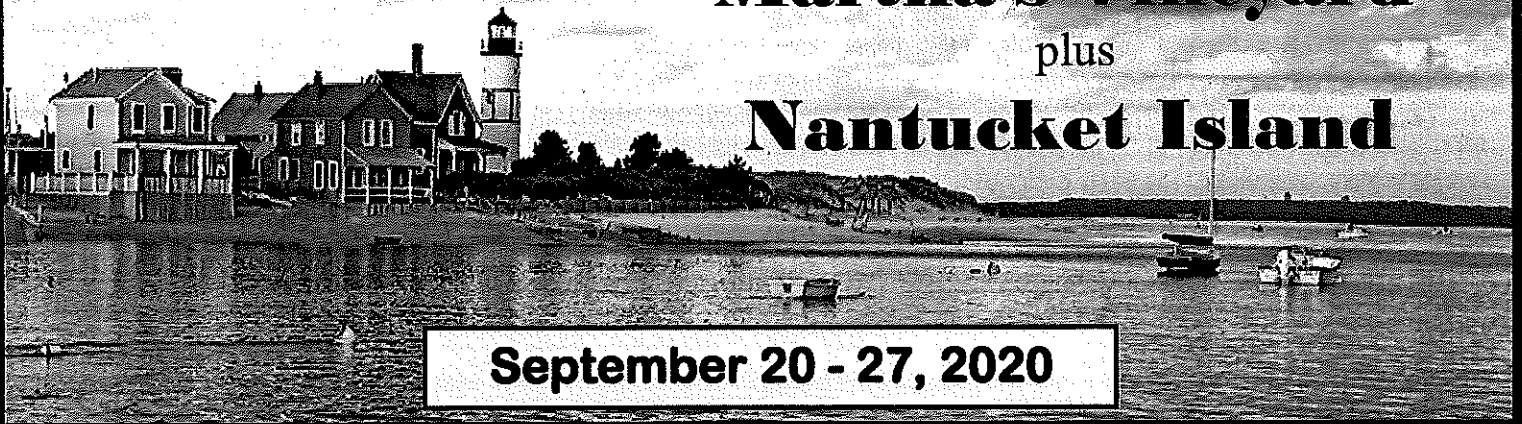

Sample Itinerary:

DAY 1— With September being the best month of the year to travel, we'll set out on a first class vacation to beautiful **Cape Cod**. The families will be long gone, the weather is mild and the ocean is still warm from summer temperatures. Overnight in Pennsylvania.

DAY 2— Early afternoon arrive in Plymouth for sightseeing tour with highlights including **Plymouth Rock, Mayflower II and the National Monument of the Forfather**. This afternoon we'll arrive in **South Yarmouth Cape Cod at the Red Jacket Beach Resort**, an award-winning , charming oceanfront resort. Visit **St. Francis Xavier Church** and hear the history of the church and its relationship with the Kennedy family through the years.
