Friday , July 3/20 - Travel to eastern Pennsylvania and overnight

Saturday , July 4/20 - Breakfast included. A morning tour of **West Point Military Academy** starts our day. Monday ,July 6/20- Breakfast included. Tour the **Federal Hall National Memorial**, where George Washington took the oath of office as the first President. This was also the site and home to the first Congress, Supreme Court, and Executive Branch offices. Now, the building serves as a museum and memorial to the first President and the beginnings of the United States of America. Next, we understand many travelers have been to New York City, so we will give you a **couple options**

#1-9/11 Museum: the museum serves as the country's principal institution concerned with exploring the complications of the events of 9/11, documenting the impact of those events and exploring 9/11's continuing significance.

OR

#2-One World Trade Center- the new and already iconic landmark and a bold addition to the skyline. Soaring to a symbolic 1776 feet—it is the Western Hemisphere's tallest building. Views of Manhattan's Skyline are spectacular!

We will return to our hotel around 3 p.m. and the rest of the day is yours to explore. Landmark New York City attractions are close by. There's so much to do .Enjoy!

Tuesday , July 7/20 - Breakfast Included. Go behind-the-scenes at the **Worlds Most Famous Arena—Madison Square Gardens**.
