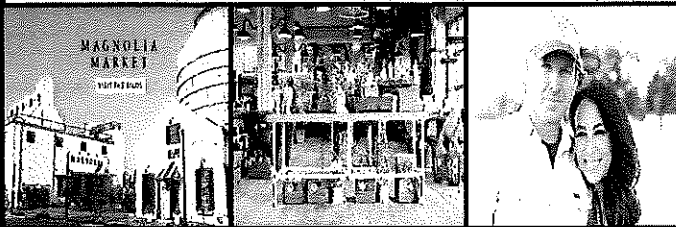

Sample Itinerary:

- Day 1**—Travel to **St. Charles, MO** and overnight at the **Ameristar Casino**, a 4-star casino resort. **Dinner is included.**
- Day 2**—Head to **Springfield, MO** for our next night. En route tour **Fantastic Caverns, America's only Ride-Thru Cavern** and one of only 4 in the world. Clint and Kelly Harp founded Harp Design Co with the hope that each piece of handmade furniture brings people together, carving out space for family meals, work, art projects, or sharing a cup of coffee. Overnight in Waco. **Dinner included.**
- Day 8**—Tour the **Dr. Pepper Museum** which tells the story of the invention of the famous soft drink. Next tour the **Texas Rangers Hall of Fame** and learn about the history and appreciation of the Texas Rangers, a legendary and iconic symbol of Texas and the America West. Continue to **San Antonio** for our next **(2) nights**. Lodging at the **Drury Inn & Suites San Antonio Riverwalk**, with an excellent location on the Riverwalk. This historically renovated hotel is a "stones throw" from countless shops, boutiques, galleries, pubs, cafes, restaurants and world famous riverboat cruises.
